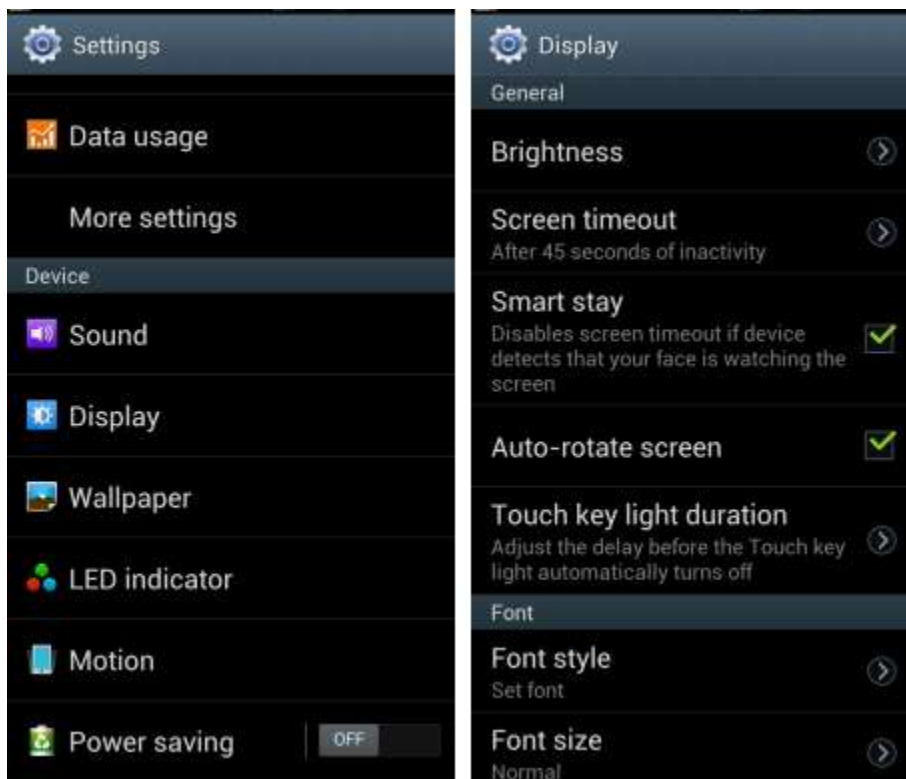


How to use Smart Stay on the Galaxy S3

Setting up Smart Stay

Smart Stay watches you watching your screen. If you are watching your screen, it keeps the brightness up for the best user experience. When you stop watching your screen, Smart Stay dims the screen. Smart Stay is set up through the Settings app.

- Pull down the Notification drawer
- Click on the Settings icon
- Scroll to Display and tap
- Scroll down to Smart Stay and put a check in the box



You will then see a pop up window about Smart Stay and when it won't work:

- When the front camera can't detect a face
- When using the device in the dark
- When the front camera is being used already in an app like Skype or a Google hangout



Adjusting screen timeout

Smart Stay will come on when you have reached the screen timeout time limit. You can adjust this by following the steps above to go to the Display settings.

- Tap the Screen timeout tab
- Choose any interval from 15 seconds to 10 minutes
